Agricultural Permit \$100

Annual Agricultural Permits allow loads up to 90,000 pounds and are issued only to Mercer County Property Owners (without regard to the number of vehicles) for agricultural purposes and are not valid during frost restrictions.

(Annual Permits Expire Dec 31 of the year issued.)

Commercial Agricultural Permit \$500

Annual Commercial Agricultural Permit allows the commercial movement of any of the following vehicles or loads, not exceeding 90,000 pounds: hay, grain, fertilizer, grain cleaner, hay grinder, forage harvester, fertilizer spreader and agricultural chemical applicator behing transported by another vehicle and are not valid during frost restrictions.

(Annual Permits Expire Dec 31 of the year issued)

Paved County Roads 5, 7, 13, and 37 has a weight limit of 65,000 pounds. County Road 21 North of HWY 200 to County Road 26 and a portion of County Road 15 up to Coteau Properties has a weight limit of 105,500; anything over this requires an overweight permit.
