

**Mercer County Commission Minutes
June 3, 2026**

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Vice Chairman Jamee Folk. Present were Commissioners Steve Guenther, Gene Wolf, Casey Voigt, Auditor Carmen Reed, and Dan Arens of the Hazen Star. Rick Bauman was absent. Wolf moved to approve the amended agenda. Voigt seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried. Amendments to the agenda include Planning & Zoning Subcommittee Meeting update and State Public Comment Policy.

Guenther moved to approve the May 20, 2026 regular meeting minutes as presented, with the following changes; On page 1, first paragraph change "Case" to Chase," add "Wes Klein." On page 2, 6th line down, change "Basin Electric Cooperative Director of Community and Member Relations Chad Reisenauer" to "Next Era Project Development Director Chase Dauenhauer." Voigt seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Building Maintenance Supervisor Jim Albers requested the purchase of safety bollards for the Stanton fuel tank and for the Beulah Building site fuel tank. Voigt moved to approve the purchase of 4 bollards for a maximum cost of \$4,000. Wolf seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried. Albers presented the 2026 WSI CEG Safety Check for \$35,338.26 and requested that it be used for risk management activities that aid in making the workplace safe. Voigt moved to approve the deposit of the CEG Safety Check of \$35,338.26 into the Risk Management (WSI) Fund #2105. Guenther seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Hazen Legion Member and Hazen Scout Master Steven Eid requested permission to hold a Flag Retirement Ceremony on Saturday, June 13th at 10 a.m. at the Riverside Park in Hazen. The Fire Department, Legion and Scouts will be in attendance and this event is open to the public.

The State Public Comment Policy was added to the June 17, 2026 Agenda.

Basin Electric Power Cooperative Director of Community and Member Relations Chad Reisenauer gave an overview and update on the Basin large load program.
